VERMONT INTERVENTIONAL SPINE CENTER (VISC) in Colchester, Vermont is a recently opened medical office specializing in non-operative interventional spine disorder evaluation and management.

Following discussions with VISC, Exterus Business Furniture determined that ergonomic seating was essential for this medical environment. The following chairs were selected due to their ergonomic design: Hon Pagoda® stacking chairs for the break room and Hon Versant™ chairs for the waiting room. Hon 7800 Series Task seating and 800 Series lateral files were used in both the reception area and at the nurse's station.

The private offices were outfitted with Hon Valido™ L Workstations which combines the durability of laminate with a decidedly upscale impression. Hon Park Avenue® 5000 Series executive chairs were chosen for these offices for their details, from a fully upholstered back to the warmth of select hardwood accented arms. Hon 2110 Invitation® Guest Wood chairs were also chosen for the private offices guest seating for their inviting cushions and warm wood accents.

Exterus Technology for Business worked in collaboration with Teligence Partners of Shelburne, Vermont to offer VISC the best in business technology. Together we coordinated from the outset the carrier selection, the installation of the telephone service and internet connections and the installation of the telephone system. A traditional Comdial DX-120™ PBX (private branch exchange) phone system was selected for its flexibility and expandability. Cabling and installation of the phones, programming an auto-attendant, configuration of the system to route calls according to the needs of the practice, ten extensions, voice mail and staff training were included in the package. An Exterus Xerox Authorized sales representative specified and installed a Xerox WorkCentre™ 232 copier; a 32 ppm machine that makes multi-tasking easy. Exterus also provided consulting services to custom integrate the clients IBM medical billing system for the WorkCentre 232™ solution.
